Club initiatives in support of night economy in Hong Kong

1. Happy Wednesday (mid-September – December 2023)

- Free admission to Happy Valley Racecourse with bigger and better Happy Wednesday (20 September to December 2023)
- The Greatest Show in Town (20 and 27 September 2023) – A vibrant carnival that celebrates the best of East and West, alongside live acts, performances by jugglers and acrobats, live music and traditional Chinese dance.
- Oktoberfest (4, 11 and 18 October 2023) – A Bavarian beer hall experience with live music, folk dance performances, and a tasty traditional menu.
- Race in Style (1, 8, 15 and 22 November 2023) – Experience the most fashionable racing occasions in Hong Kong with style and glamour.
- Prelude to LONGINES International Jockeys' Championship and Hong Kong International Races (29 Nov and 6 December 2023) – Witness the world's best jockeys in action in the heart of the city in the run-up to a celebration of world-class international races in Hong Kong.
- Winter Wonderland (13, 20 and 27 December 2023) – Celebrate the festive season with mulled wine, a Christmas menu, festive lights and Swiss chalet vibes.

2. Tai Kwun (October 2023 – February 2024)

- Selected F&B outlets at Tai Kwun will extend their Happy Hour offerings to 9pm (October 2023)
- Prison Yard Festival (21 to 30 November 2023) – Night-time open-air concerts in the atmospheric Prison Yard, featuring international and local musicians
- Contemporary arts exhibition's opening hours will be extended from 7pm to 9pm once a week (December 2023)
- HKJC Presents Simple Gifts of Joy (1 December 2023 - 1 January 2024) – A Christmas tree, light shows and a series of free contemporary circus programmes featuring new international and local circus acts for the whole month. In addition, the magnificent, newly programmed Christmas tree will be lit up for the public with an opening concert – The Gift of Music – at the Parade Ground of Tai Kwun. This night-time concert will be staged on a number of nights during December.
- InnerGlow (25 January - 11 February 2024) – Designed for the whole family, InnerGlow has lit up the Parade Ground every evening with three to five shows a night for three weeks for the past two years. In this third edition, InnerGlow uses the latest digital and 3D Mapping technology to project breathtaking animation and images onto the facades of our historic buildings on a massive scale during the evenings.
